



Enduring Power of Attorney (financial) Resignation of Attorney

Note: Section 125M of the Instruments Act 1958 permits an attorney under an enduring power of attorney (financial) to resign by signed notice given to the donor. However, if the donor ceases to have legal capacity, the attorney may resign only with the leave of a court or of the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (VCAT). If the attorney resigns, the enduring power of attorney is revoked to the extent that it confers power on the attorney.
